EUREKA CITY NEWS

CITY COUNCIL MEETING:

With the start of the new year, the Eureka City Council will now be holding two work meetings per month and two regular council meetings per month, on the second and fourth Monday's. Work Meetings will commence at 6:00 pm and Council Meetings will commence at 7:00 pm.

ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS:

Eureka City has started working towards updating and codifying all of our ordinances so they can be made searchable on our website.

PLANNING COMMISSION:

Eureka once again has a functioning Planning Commission. The Commission will be meeting on the third Wednesday of each month at 7:00 pm at the Eureka City Hall, 15 North Church Street.

PERMITS:

All Building Permits, Excavation Permits, Special Event & Film Permits are all available online now using a new program called iWorQ. Anyone needing a permit can go to the city website www.eurekautah.org and apply for a permit. Just click where it says "Apply for Building Permits", you have the opportunity to put in all the required information as well as uploading all the necessary documents such as site plans/specs, contractor info., photos, etc., This makes it all more streamlined with everything all in one place, easier for the Building Inspector, Planning Commission and City Office to review and respond within a timely manner.

LICENSING:

BUSINESS: If you have a business or are thinking of starting a business in Eureka, whether in your home or in the commercial zone, you need a business license. Eureka's Business License Ordinance can be viewed on our website: www.eurekautah.org as well as having all the required paperwork that will need to be submitted in order to go through the approval process. All businesses must be registered with the Utah Division of Corporations: <https://corporations.utah.gov/online-registration-instructions/>

ANIMAL: Licenses are required for both dogs and cats in Eureka. In order to be licensed, proof of a current rabies shot is required. Eureka City holds an annual Rabies Clinic in the Spring of each year. You can watch for the signs around town in our local businesses, on our website and your emails if you are subscribed to our website to receive alerts and notifications.

CITY WEBSITE:

You can visit the City's website to see the latest news from around town, view Council Meeting Agenda's and Minutes, Ordinances & Resolutions, Youth Sports info. and more. You can also subscribe to our page to receive news and alerts via email and SMS.

UTILITY BILLING:

Eureka City still offers several ways to pay your utility bills. You can pay cash in the office, pay by check through the mail or in the office, or we have partnered with Xpress Bill Pay for the convenience of paying your bill online. 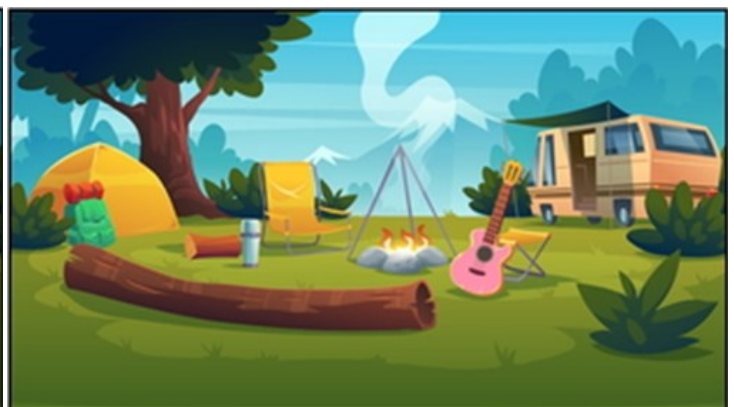
