EUREKA HAS A NEW MAYOR

Eureka City Council appointed a new Mayor on August 26, 2024, in a Special Council Meeting to fill the vacancy left by Mayor Christopher Dever.

There were three applicants: Robert Jenkins, Antoinette Dever and Tony Atherley. Mr. Atherley was not qualified to run due to not being registered to vote in Juab County and had not lived in Eureka for 12 consecutive months. The other two applicants were present at the Special Council Meeting and were both given time to stand and introduce themselves in a public interview. The Eureka City Council then voted and by unanimous decision, Antoinette Dever was chosen to fill the Interim appointment until the next regular election in 2025. Mrs. Dever was then sworn in and joined the Council at the table.

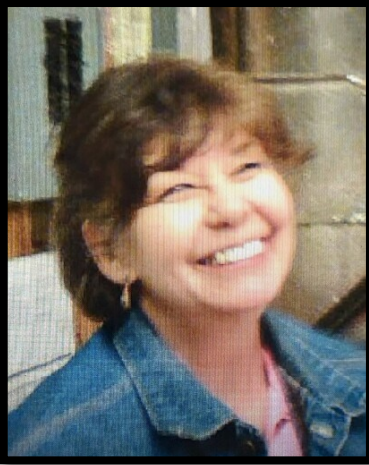

- Step 6: Select your billing organization
- Step 7: Enter your account number and last name, then click in the box to opt in for paperless and select “Locate Bill” and select “Locate Account”
