Vacancy in the Office of City Council Member

Eureka City is accepting applications to fill a vacancy for an unexpired term of Eureka City Council Member. Robert Trepanier resigned as Council Member of Eureka effective September 9, 2024.

The vacancy in the office of Council Member will be filled by an interim appointment to finish out the unexpired four-year term as Council Member. The interim appointment will be in effect until the January following the next Municipal Election held in 2025.

The appointment will take place at a Special Council Meeting to be held on Monday, October 7, 2024, at 6:00 p.m., Eureka City Offices, 15 North Church Street, Eureka, Utah 84628.

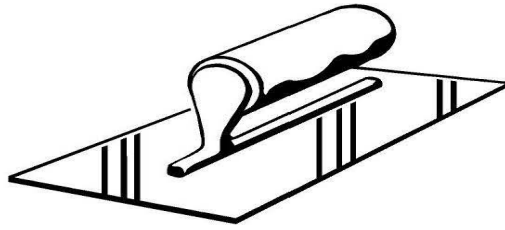
Persons interested must meet the qualifications listed below:

- Be a United States Citizen.
- Be at least 18 years old.
- Be a resident of the municipality or a resident of the recently annexed area for 12 consecutive months.
- Be a registered voter of the municipality.
- In accordance with Utah Constitution, Article IV, Section 6, a mentally incompetent individual, an individual convicted of a felony, or an individual convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to hold elective office is restored under Section [20A-2-101.3](#) or [20A-2-101.5](#).

Applications may be obtained at the City Office. Applications must be submitted to the City Recorder, prior to the deadline of Thursday, October 3, 2024, at 5:00 p.m.

Jack Thomas Garbett *April 3, 1936 ~ August 24, 2024*

Jack Thomas Garbett, age 88 of Eureka, passed away August 24, 2024, surrounded by family at Mountain View Hospital. Jack was born in Eureka on April 3, 1936, to Thomas and Clara Decker Snell Garbett and he was one of seven children.

Jack married Geraldine Evelyn Gren on December 10, 1962, in Ely, Nevada. She had five children, Sandra Fullerton, Pauline Taylor (deceased), Janet Larson, Gordon Hansen (deceased) and Bill Hansen. Together Jack and Geraldine had one daughter, Jeri. He loved Geraldine and after she passed, he would spend much time at the cemetery to visit her.
