NOTICE OF CANDIDATE DISQUALIFICATION

According to Utah State Law 10-3-208, All Candidates in a municipal election must file a Campaign Finance Disclosure with the municipality no later than 7 days before the day on which the municipal general election is held. The deadline to file the report was 5:00 pm, October 26, 2021.

If a candidate fails to timely file a campaign finance statement required under Subsection (3), the municipal clerk or recorder shall inform the voters that the candidate has been disqualified and that votes for that candidate will not be counted.

Eureka City Office received 5 of the 6 Candidates Campaign Financial Disclosures by 5:00 pm, October 26, 2021.

The candidate with the missing Campaign Financial Disclosure was William “Brian” Curtis, who was running for a 2 Yr. Council position unopposed. As the ballots have already been mailed out, his name could not be blacked out on the ballot, so any votes that Mr. Curtis receives, will not be counted.

This however leaves an opening on the City Council in January. This position will be advertised, applications taken, and the Eureka City Council will choose from the applicants the best candidate to fill an interim appointment for a two-year term on the Eureka City Council.
