ORDINANCE NO. 2024-01-08-01

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ALONG MAIN STREET / HIGHWAY 6, PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE AND EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THE ORDINANCE.

PREAMBLE:

WHEREAS U.S. Highway 6 runs partly through the city limits of Eureka City and is known also as Main Street within Eureka; and

WHEREAS overnight parking along Main Street overnight creates issues for the public health, safety, and welfare of the City, and therefore, the Eureka City Council finds that the adoption of this Ordinance would promote the public health, safety and welfare of the City.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Eureka, Utah, that:

SECTION I.

It shall be unlawful for any person who owns or has possession, custody or control of any motor vehicle to park or knowingly allow to be parked any vehicle on or along U.S. Highway 6, also known as Main Street, within Eureka city limits overnight.

SECTION II. PENALTIES

Violators may be ticketed and /or towed or booted by the City. If said vehicles are towed, they shall be impounded until the owner has paid the reasonable costs of towing/booting and storage.

Violation of any provision of this chapter may be prosecuted as a Class C Misdemeanor.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY

If any provision or clause of this chapter or its application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other sections, provisions, clauses, or applications which can be implemented without the invalid provision, clause, or application. To this end, the provisions of this chapter are declared to be severable.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall become effective on the date passed by the City Council of Eureka.
