

WHO: Utah Abandoned Mine Reclamation Program (AMRP)

WHAT: AMRP is planning to close 82 abandoned mines in Juab County. The project is located on private land. The work consists of backfilling or grating 72 vertical and 10 horizontal hardrock mine openings to protect public safety. Protective measures will be carried out to retain the historic mining landscape and properties.

WHEN: The project is tentatively scheduled for April 2018 and is expected to last 4 weeks.

WHERE: The project is approximately 5 miles south of Eureka, Utah in T11S, R2W Sections 6 and 7 and T11S, R3W Section 1.
